Tuberculosis Screening Questionnaire

For the past several years, JBU has **recommended** incoming students have a TB skin test within the past year or so. This is for the student's well being since most of our students take part in ministry opportunities that put them in situations where Tuberculosis could be contracted.

Due to a new Arkansas State Law regarding Act 96 of 1913, John Brown University now **requires** all incoming students who were **born in or who have lived for longer than six months in countries where Tuberculosis is endemic** to show documentation of a negative TB skin test or documentation of a negative chest x-ray and treatment if TB skin test was positive.

If you were born or lived in a foreign country that is NOT listed below, you will need to have a TB test done in the US and no more than 6 mos before your first day of class. You have 45 days into the semester to fulfill this requirement. I will send you a form that must be completed by the TB test provider. (You can also get the form at www.jbu.edu/campus_life/student/health/index.asp)

The test must be

- Mantoux method
- Done within 6 mos of the school term beginning
- Done in the US or Canada
- Negative results (induration of less than 10mm)
- Documented with name, address and signature of provider
